- Lawyers available to offer advice on Family Law issues. Immigration law available by appointment.
- Victim Advocates, Community Action, DCFS, Department of Workforce Services (DWS), Housing Authority, and other resources available at the clinic

BYU Law Help: 801-422-3025

- Legal counseling for low-income individuals. Call one week before to make an appointment

Timpanogos Legal Center (TLC): 801-649-8895

- Offers an online Document Clinic for prescreened clients who are self-represented (no attorney)
- Volunteer attorneys will then assist in drafting documents relating to divorce and custody cases

Utah Legal Services (ULS): 801-374-6766

- ULS can answer questions, give advice, prepare legal documents, and represent clients in court. Can assist with protective orders, divorce, or custody cases.
- Call for an intake between the hours of 9 a.m.-2 p.m., Monday through Friday

Protective Orders. A court-issued protective order is designed to give victims of domestic violence protection by preventing the abuser from having contact with, threatening, or entering onto the property of a victim. There is NO CHARGE to obtain a protective order. Assistance with a protective order may be obtained by contacting your local victim advocate or going to www.utcourts.gov/ocap.

- Also provides donated professional clothing for women as they enter school and/or the workforce. Clothing vouchers are available for men
- Call to make an appointment

- Assists individuals to develop the skills they need to find employment, as well as job search assistance

- An employment program that teaches low-income individuals how to earn an adequate income through stable employment
